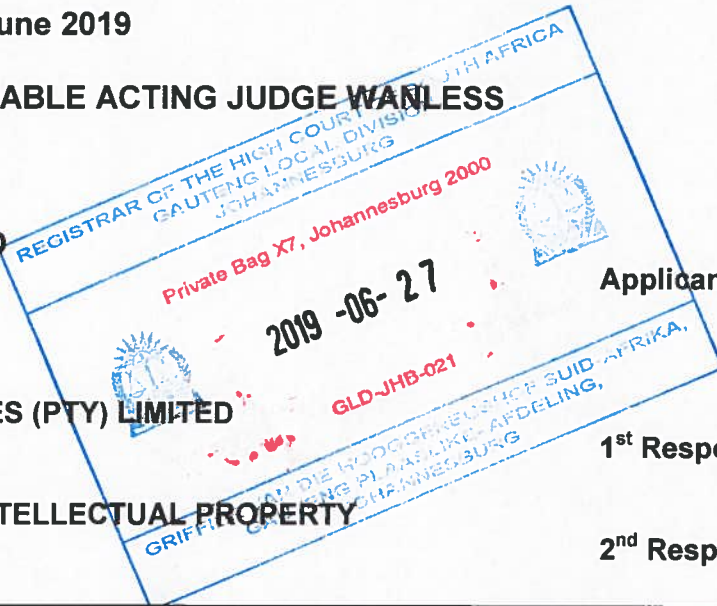

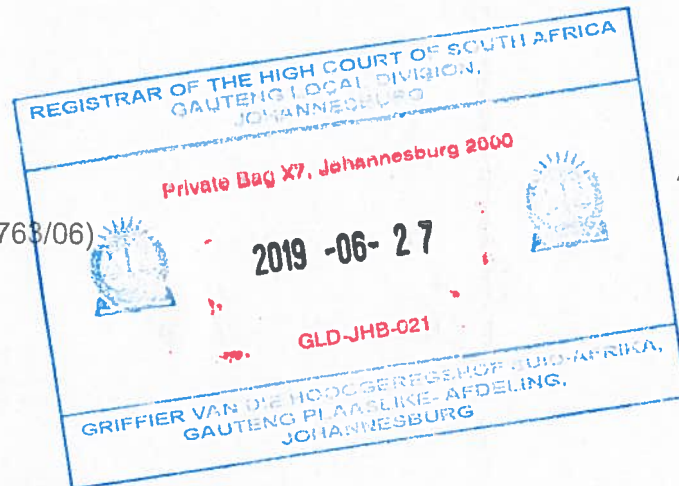

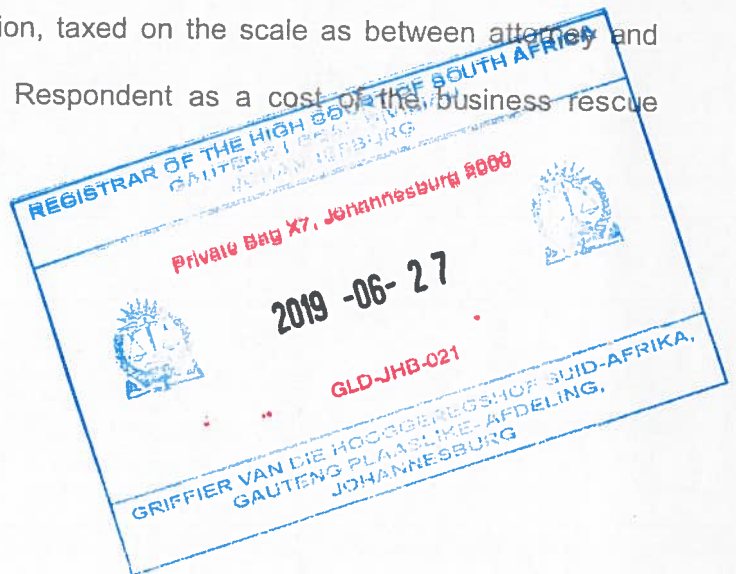
HAVING READ the papers filed of record and having heard counsel for the applicant, the following order is made:

*K*

1. The First Respondent is placed under supervision and business rescue proceedings commenced in terms of section 131 of the Act;
2. Mr Gavin Cecil Gainsford is appointed as interim business rescue practitioner of the First Respondent;
3. The Applicant is to give notice of this Order in the following manner:
  - 3.1. By notifying creditors of the First Respondent of the Order, within 3 (three) days of the Order having been granted, by way of electronic mail;
  - 3.2. By notifying shareholders of the First Respondent, within 3 (three) days of the Order having been granted, by way of electronic mail;
  - 3.3. By serving a copy of the Order on the First Respondent at its Registered Office within 3 (three) days of the Order having been granted;
  - 3.4. By notifying employees of the First Respondent by way of attaching a copy of the Order to a prominent and visible place at the business premises of the First Respondent situated at its principal place of business, within 3 (three) days of the Order having been granted;
4. The Applicant's costs of this application, taxed on the scale as between attorney and client, shall be payable by the First Respondent as a cost of the business rescue proceedings.
